Code of Conduct for Academy Members/Young Players – 2022/2023

When training for and playing football, I will:

- Comply with the requirements of my team managers and coaches.
- Always play to the best of my ability and for the benefit of my team
- Play fairly – I won't cheat, dive, complain or waste time.
- Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee and my coaches and management.
- Play by the rules, as directed by the referee or my coaches and management.
- Be gracious in victory and defeat – I will shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game, and with my team-mates on arrival and departure from training sessions and fixtures.
- Listen and respond to what my coaches and management tell me.
- Understand that coaches have to do what is best for the team and not one individual player.
- Promptly provide all contact details required by the Club.
- Ensure together with my team-mates that changing rooms and other facilities (at both home and away matches, and when training) are left clean and tidy after I have finished using them.
- Prepare my kit bag for training sessions and fixtures, ensuring that I have everything I need including clean boots.
- Arrive at EJA fixtures in smart clothing or a Club tracksuit.
- Ask my parent or guardian to ensure when requested by the Club that kit is ordered and paid for (and where appropriate returned) in a timely way.
- Ensure that arrangements are made to pay any fines levied on me by the FA/Cambs FA within one week (the amount payable to the Cambs FA is doubled if not paid within 10 days).
- Comply with the Club's Safeguarding and Anti-Bullying policies, which can be accessed from the Club's website.
- Talk to someone I trust or the Club Welfare Officer if I'm unhappy about anything in relation to my training or the Club.

I understand that, if I do not follow this code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by the Club, the Cambs FA or The FA as appropriate. I may:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, referee or coaches and management.
- Receive a formal warning from my coaches and management or the Club Board.
- Be dropped or substituted from competitive football.
- Be suspended from training.
- Be required to leave the Club.

- The FA/Cambs FA could impose a fine and suspension against the Club.
